This past Sunday was Children's Sabbath. Thank you to Jane Gibbs and the UMW for leading the church in a beautiful service of worship and celebration of children. I was excited to see so many children in worship and experience the excitement each child expressed during the children's sermon. In that sermon, Jane Gibbs shared a word and concept with the children that they are BELOVED by God. I hope the adults were paying attention to Jane's thoughts. We all need to reminded that we are the BELOVED ... that God calls beloved and loves us – period, full stop. Put aside any notions that God's love is conditional. God's love is given freely. Jane led the children in a prayer; asking them to repeat each line after her. There was some struggling with remembering the words they just heard, but the effort to repeat the words of praise and thanksgiving, and to acknowledge their belovedness is a gift to us and especially to God.

Above these remarks is a photo of the message card Jane used to show our children the word BELOVED to emphasize the importance of their and our understanding of how God relates to us ... In the next few months we will continue to explore the depth of this reality of our belovedness in study groups and in Sunday worship. Our understanding that God calls us the Beloved, and our claiming this truth as our own, is essential as we seek to grow in our faith, and as we work to be faithful disciples of Jesus Christ. Knowing and claiming our identity as the Beloved of God is the foundation of sharing that truth with each other and our neighbor.


