Jesus says, "Take my yoke upon you", Jesus offers it to us. He says "this yoke is kind, and my burden is light." Jesus says to us "


Discover the freedom of resting in my love and my teachings. You will find rest for your souls."

Thank you for your continued gleaning for the poor each Sunday. Through the Fairgrove Family Resource Center, many with financial difficulties will not go hungry.

The United Methodist conferences in North Carolina work together in partnership some 6,000 miles away in Armenia. Long-standing, multi-layered conflict prevents any other humanitarian group from working with the people of this area, who struggle in life. Project AGAPE has shared the love of Christ by continuing projects for more than two decades. The Christmas boxes will go to Armenian children who would not have a Christmas gift without this project. If you would like to shop and fill a box, pick up a girl or boy's form in the church entryway. For someone to shop for you, checks may be made in July or early August to FGUMC (AGAPE on the memo line) or see Janice Griffin. We are also asked to provide \$5 per box for shipping.

Thank you for your continued gleaning for the poor each Sunday. Through the FFRC, thanks to you, many with financial difficulties will not go hungry. The gift cards to fast food, grocery stores, and gas stations have been helping those who have been in urgent need of assistance. We are now in need of gas cards. Thanks also from the Missions Committee for your many donations for the Davidson County Women's Shelter.






Hands-on Mission project – Bring a \$1 (or 2) to support the Armenia shoebox ministry.


