A Moment with Pastor Mark AKA Mark's Musings

Who Exactly Was Charlie Kirk? What exactly was Charlie Kirk? He was labeled a martyr by the Christian community. But what is a martyr? According to definitions, a martyr is a person who is killed because of their religious or other beliefs. And he was. But he was killed, not for his beliefs, but because he voiced his beliefs. In the History of the Christian Church, let me name you just a few of the martyrs. Nearly all of the Old Testament prophets were martyred, that is, they chose to take the Word of God to the people, unwavering in what God told them to say. Only they were not only killed for what they said, but they were killed because they lived it as well. They were sought out by kings and rulers who persecuted them. They escaped death many times over before finally being captured. Then there were the martyrs of he gospel of Jesus Christ, and like the prophets, they too not only preached the Word, they lived the Word. The Old Testament prophets had only visions, dreams, and sometimes direct words from a God they could not see or touch. The New Testament had their examples to follow, however, they also had the Son of God as their visual and audible example. Today and for the past 2000 years, we have had the example of the prophets, the actual words of Jesus, the teachings of the Apostles, and thousands of examples of men and women who not only stand up for the Gospel of Christ, but live it day in and day out. All over the world, men and women, even whole groups of people are dying just like Charlie Kirk because they believe in the Gospel message. However, I wish to give them another label: they were committed Christians. They were not partially committed, they were FULLY committed. They were unwavering in their beliefs, unwavering in their voice, and unwavering in their actions. They were committed to the truth, voiced the truth, and lived the truth. Now, let's get to the heart of the matter. That is what God expects from every person who call themselves a Christian. Folks, that is you and me. Let's not forget Jesus' famous words in Luke 9 when He said, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me." Remember that he followed those words with this; "Whoever is ashamed of me and my words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his glory and in the glory of the Father and of the holy angels." Jesus will not be ashamed of Charlie Kirk. I pray that Jesus will not be ashamed of you.




