A Moment with Pastor Mark AKA Mark's Musings

As a Methodist, one of the challenges of a pastor is the annual meeting of the nominations committee. I say annual because it is the time of year that we recruit church members for serving in various capacities. However, it is hardly EVER a single meeting. We will meet and scrutinize the different offices that we have in the church as well as make changes to certain committees where people are coming off of committees and need to be replaced by others. In small churches, we often have to recycle people around from one job to another or one committee to another in order to satisfy not only the needs of the church but the requirements of our Global Methodist Conference. This has been very challenging for most churches in that we are a new denomination and are still learning about what we need.

Most of the readers of this article have some connection with Fair Grove Church, either past members, family, current members, and others. So I would like to take this opportunity to address every Christian reading this regardless of whether you attend Fair Grove or not. Don't wait to be asked to serve in some capacity in your church; seek out opportunities in your church and volunteer to serve in some capacity. The minister of a church is often reduced to begging people to serve in the church and that is not the way it's supposed to work.

Paul tells us in 1 Corinthians 12:14 that "the body of believers, the church, is not made up of one part but of many. But in fact, God has placed the parts of the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be." Think about this; God has saved you and prepared you for where you are supposed to be. God has a plan for every one of us, but sometimes we need to seek out, realize, and understand what He has in store for each of us individually! Paul says in verse 27, "Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it."

I leave you with this challenge: if you are a member of a church regardless of where it is, seek out your pastor or your nominations committee and ask them where you can serve. God has given you gifts uniquely suited for you individually. And if you are a member of Fair Grove, don't wait for the committee or pastor to come to you. Seek them out and let them know how and where you would like to serve. I remind you that God saved us, and by way of serving Him, he simply asks us to serve one another. 
