In <u>1 Thessalonians 5:18</u>, Paul instructs us to "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" And so, yes, even when we don't understand, we are to thank Him.

You see, God knows things that we don't. He simply asks us to trust Him. His omniscience proves that he has only the best for us because he knows the outcome of every possible circumstance in our lives. Nothing escapes God's all seeing, all knowing, all powerful eye! 
